Call to Order: 8:02 p.m.

Order of Business:

- 1) Open Discussion
 - a. The group discussed status of information finding related to the Aspen Trails Water Company. Documentation is incomplete on some of the well permits and title transfers, which has slowed progress.
 - b. The Boltons enquired about Christiansen Agreement which permits the use of ATMD roads to access the large property just north of ATMD. They expressed a general concern regarding road damage that may be caused by large construction vehicles and equipment using ATMD roads to access the property.

- 2) Road Report
 - a. Roads have significant wash boarding on hills and high traffic area. Timmerwerk completed touch up work on trouble areas.
 - b. Ridgecrest project is complete, along with work on Aspen Loop. The Board is satisfied with the quality of work and result. The Forest Service liked the result of mitigation work on Ridgecrest.
 - c. Speed bump removal is planned for November 15, along with additional road maintenance and grading in preparation for winter.
 - d. Southwest AG will deliver the tractor in early December.
- 3) Financial Report
 - a. Discussed spending versus budget. All spending is within budget.
 - b. Brad provided a draft 2021 budget by the October 15 deadline. The Board will review and discus the draft budget at the December meeting. The Board approved posting required budget meeting notices in the Herald. (Motion)
